Privacy Policy

Your privacy is critically important to us. At EYSC, we have a few fundamental principals:

- We don't ask you for personal information unless we truly need it.
- We don't share your personal information with anyone except to comply with the law.
- We don't share personal information on our servers unless required for the on-going operation of one of our services.

EYSC uses technology to provide you with the safest, most secure experience possible. EYSC enables encryption of sensitive information during your online registration. All forms are secured so your personal information stays safe and out of malicious hands.

Refund Policy

Recreational: No refunds are given after registration closes, with exceptions for hardships (serious injury, child custody, etc). Requests are reviewed on a case by case basis. Absolutely no refunds will be issued to those families that cannot participate in Sunday games prior to the registration close date.

Competitive: No refunds are given, with exceptions for hardships (serious injury, child custody, etc). Each request will be reviewed on a case by case basis. If a refund is given, a \$150 administrative fee will be assessed and a pro-rated portion of the paid amount will be refunded.

Weather Policy

Inclusion Policy
